# A TRIBUTE TO SAUMUR'S RIVER HISTORY

Crossed by the Loire river, for centuries the town of Saumur was a central platform of fluvial trade between Nantes and the region around Paris. Local wooden sailing boats were especially used at the time to transport wine and various agricultural products. This wine refers to these vessels, which contributed to the rise of the wines of Saumur.

#### **VINE-GROWING & WINEMAKING**

Grape variety: Chenin Blanc. Soils/Terroirs: Chalky-clay. Vineyard: Situated in the district of Puy-Notre-Dame.

Winemaking: A double fermentation (alcoholic and malolactic) is carried out in barrels to develop delicate oaky notes. The wine is matured for a period of 10 months in barrels with stirring on lees in view of bringing about fat and roundness. Maturing period: 10 months in barrels

#### **THE VINEYARD**

The vineyard's parcels are close together and begin on the hilltop of the hamlet of Argentay, at an altitude of around 90 meters. They face Southwest and stretch along a geological formation, renowned for its terroir and called the flow of Cerisaie. The chalky clay soils are made up of green and white limestone, especially adapted to Chenin.



COLOR Pale yellow with golden tints.

AROMAS Well ripened white fruit aromas with a hint of vanilla, joined by toasted and spicy notes.

**ON THE PALATE Frank and strong attack.** Aromas of

dried apricots with grilled notes. Round with a long and elegant finish.

#### FOOD PAIRING

Seafood, sea scallops, sole meunière and hard cheese.

Serving temperature: between 8 and 10°C

Potential for ageing : 8 years

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Loire Valley wines flourish in a unique cultural landscape, classified as a UNESCO World Heritage site. The Loire Valley vineyard extends over 65,000 hectares within 4 regions – Pays Nantais, Anjou-Saumur, Touraine and Centre Loire. All and all, this wine route represents a distance of 800 km.

The Loire Valley is France's 3rd largest winegrowing region. Stretching from the Atlantic coast to the Centre region, it is a point of equilibrium, where North meets South, sophistication meets freshness, art meets literature, and tradition meets modernity. These harmonious contrasts - plus the generally temperate climate and extraordinarily varied terroirs - have produced the world's most diverse array of wines. As a result, France's longest river is capable of providing a rich selection of over 50 still and sparkling AOP and PGI wines and over 10 varieties (Chenin, Sauvignon, Chardonnay, Melon de Bourgogne, Cabernet Franc...). All of the wines are in the nature of the Loire Valley.

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# **LE MOULIN CAVIER** Saumur Champigny Rouge – 2017

Finesse and Concentration

#### A TRIBUTE TO THE HERITAGE OF SAUMUR

East of the castle of Saumur and overlooking the Loire is the well-known rue des moulins. At the beginning of last century, this street boasted up to 32 windmills located throughout the heart of the vineyard of Saumur Champigny. These windmills are built upon cellars, sometimes troglodytic ones – hence their names evoking caverns. At the time, millers used to make wine. This cuvée was created in tribute to this patrimony and its exceptional terroir.

#### **VINE-GROWING & WINEMAKING**

Grape variety: Cabernet Franc. Soils/Terroirs: Limestone soil. Vineyard: Old low yielding vines producing rich and highly concentrated grapes.

Winemaking: When the harvest arrives in the cellar it is sorted to remove leaves and damaged fruit. The grapes undergo a cold maceration to gently extract aromas and color. Last but not least, the wine is matured in barrels to develop its complexity and intensity.

Maturing period: about a year in barrels.

#### **THE VINEYARD**

Saumur Champigny appellation extends across the limestone slopes of the Loire's right bank around the town of Saumur, representing a total surface area of 1,500 ha.

The appellation's name means «fields of fire» in Latin (campus igni), with reference to the especially hot micro-climate during the summertime. Chiefly derived from Cabernet Franc, the wines of Saumur Champigny are dense, fleshy and elegant with tannins that are at once intense and supple.

COLOR T Intense garnet color.

AROMAS T Black berries (black berries, wild berries) with toasted notes.

**ON THE PALATE** Ample and well-balanced. Aromas of black berries, spices (red pepper) and

moka.

**FOOD PAIRING** 

Red meat (roast beef, veal, lamb and grilled duck breast), cheese (brie or Ossau Iraty) and chocolate dessert (black forest or chocolate cake and red berries).

Serving temperature: 16°C

Potential for ageing : 8 years

# CHINON LES BOIRES Dry red – 2014

Powerful and Silky

#### **IN HOMAGE TO THE LOIRE**

This oak aged Chinon is a tribute to the Loire, the longest river in France. It has breathed new life into "Les Boires", a word referring to ancient isolated meanders, with or without water, for part or all of the year. Originating from this area, the French writer, Francois Rabelais, used this term in his novels, so the brand equally evokes this famous author. 2014 is a very nice vintage.

#### **VINE-GROWING & WINEMAKING**

Grape variety: Cabernet Franc

**Soils/ Terroirs**: A blend of two terroirs – one is hilly with chalky-clay soil, the other comprises a sandladen soil. This combination produces a wine that is at once harmonious and well-balanced.

Winemaking: Parcel selection. In-house winemaking, monitored by our oenologists on a weekly basis and age ageing in our cellars. Bottling is undertaken only when the wine has reached optimum maturity to preserve richness and fruity notes.

**Maturing period:** from 12 to 18 months in barrels, including 20% in new barrels.

#### **THE VINEYARD**

Derived from three plots, most of the grapes used to produce this wine are hand picked. The parcels called Saut aux loups and Villy are situated on chalky-clay slopes, producing concentrated and tannic wines. Maisons Bourdeaux is a parcel situated in the plain with a sandy soil, providing fruity notes and depth. **TASTING NOTES** 

COLOR Good intensity.

AROMAS T Red and black berries, blended with notes of torrefied cocoa and toasted bread.

# ON THE PALATE $\Upsilon$

Round with good density. The wine's structure is brought about by the tannins provided by the Cabernet Franc variety and oak ageing. Very nice body, with a hint of bitterness.

#### **FOOD PAIRING**

Wild boar terrine, mushroom pie, duck nems, beef stew, roast game birds, saint-nectaire cheese

Serving temperature: between 15 and 16°C

Potential for ageing : 10 years

Decanter 2018: silver



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Maturing period: from 12 in barrels from 1 to 3 wines.

#### **THE VINEYARD**

The grapes come from three different plots. Two of them - « Saut aux Loups » and « Villy » - are located on hilly chalky-clay sil and produce concentrated and tanin wines (1/3 of the blend). « Les Maisons Bourdeaux » is located on a sandy plain and brings fruitiness and deepness (2/3 of the blend).



COLOR Good intensity.

AROMAS T Red and black berries, blended with notes of liquorice.

ON THE PALATE T Elegant with finesse. Silky tanins. Final on fruity notes and undergrowth.

#### **FOOD PAIRING**

Poultry, veal, salads.

Serving temperature: between 15 and 16°C

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# **SANCERRE N7** Dry white - 2014

Complex and Expressive

#### **IN HOMAGE TO HIGHWAY 7**

This wine is a nostalgic reference to the mythical French highway, Nationale 7, that Parisians used to take to to drive down to the Riviera for their holidays ... and that went via Sancerre. This is the most popular road in France, representing a distance of 996 km from the heart of Paris to the border of Italy, and passing through a breathtaking array of terroirs.

#### VINE-GROWING & WINEMAKING

#### Grape variety: Sauvignon Blanc

Soils/Terroirs: A blend of 3 typical Sancerre terroirs: flint stone, stony-limestone and clay-limestone. Winemaking: This premium wine is the fruit of a meticulous selection undertaken by our oenologists (choice of soils and parcels beforehand, fine-tuned winemaking) and takes advantage of all the diversity of AOP Sancerre. Indeed, this wine brings together the 3 terroirs representing this appellation. The typical features of each contribute to its profile: mineral notes from the flint stone, structure from the stony-limestone and fruit from the clay-limestone. Careful blending and maturing on fine lees come afterwards. This wine's opulence is communicated by its ample bottle and the drawing on the label evokes the highway's route. It is an offering for Epicureans in general and for Epicurean moments. Maturing period: 6 months on fine lees.

#### **THE VINEYARD**

Due to its landscape and complex geology, Sancerre boasts highly different terroirs. Exposition, altitude, soil type and water reserve are elements that mark the extremely expressive Sauvignon grape variety differently, depending upon the conditions of the vintage. This diversity is an asset, specific to great appellations. The grapes from the stony-limestone plots called Caillottes produce nervous and fruity wines. The clay-limestone terroirs known as Terres Blanches are very rich with plenty of aromatic finesse. When blended they often create the wine's body due to their complexity and strength. The flintstone terroirs produce wines that are taunter. more straight forward, more mineral, more acid and more spicy.



COLOR T Pale yellow with discreet golden tints.

AROMAS At once fruity, floral and vegetal: yellow fleshed fruit, white flowers and fresh aromatic herbs.

**ON THE PALATE** Rich and concentrated, mineral notes and freshness, aromatic complexity.

#### **FOOD PAIRING**

Asparagus, cottage cheese with herbs, fish.

Serving temperature: between 10 and 12°C

Potential for ageing : 8 years

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# **LE MASTER** *Muscadet Sèvre et Maine Dry white - 2016*

Finesse and Concentration

# **« 1984 »**

In keeping with tradition, each year, our oenologists, trade partners and buyers meet up at Chateau de la Cassemichère in Muscadet in view of selecting from several blends, this great wine, born in 1984. For a long time, this castle was the private property of the Bahuaud family and Donatien even looked for hidden treasures here. Awarded medals on a regular basis, Le Master boasts good ageing potential.

#### VINE-GROWING & WINEMAKING

Grape variety: Melon de Bourgogne. Soils/Terroirs: Gneiss and orthogneiss, a continuity of the Armorican massif.

Vines: 35 years old, Guyot Nantais pruning. Vinification details: The harvest is transformed into wine in underground vats, a common practice in this region, making use of the soil's thermal inertia. This is even more true when it comes to the maturing stage that is carried out at a constant temperature. Aged on lees (the deposit of dead yeast after the first fermentation), this wine is stirred on a regular basis to extract their aromatic particles. They develop the wine's ageing potential. The blends are then blind tasted to identify the one best representing le Master brand. Ageing-potential is the chief quality guiding this choice! Maturing period: 6 months on lees.

#### **THE VINEYARD**

Situated in the most northern part of the Nantais vineyard, the terroir of Le Master is made up of rocks from the Armorican massif. From an agronomic point of view, these soils are poor, however they are well suited to vine-growing. They promote the growth of well-ripened grapes, meeting the quality criteria of this brand. The high plantation density (7,000 vine stocks per hectare), limits the yield and fosters concentration.



#### **FOOD PAIRING**

In the light of its matter, Le Master is very pleasant as an aperitif, but goes perfectly well with sea food and fish, as well as sea scallops.

Potential for ageing : 10 years

This prestigious wine pays tribute to the magnificent library of the castle next to this vineyard, containing 12,000 listed works. Careful maturing has enhanced this Pouilly Fumé which displays crisp and mineral notes reflecting its terroir.

#### VINE-GROWING & WINEMAKING

Grape variety: Sauvignon

 $\operatorname{{\sf Sols}}$  /  $\operatorname{{\sf Terroirs}}$  : sandy and stony soil with plenty of flintstone

Vinification details : Our oenologists take great care when making this wine. After direct pressing, the fermentation is carried out at a low temperature in thermoregulated vats. Well mastered temperatures favor the development of the Sauvignon's delicate aromas. The presence of sulphites is reduced by the use of neutral gas which limits the risk of oxidation and conserves the harvest's freshness and fruity aromas.

Maturing period : 4 months

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# **TOURAINE** Les Chârtes White – 2018 Refined and fruity

#### «A TRIBUTE TO DONATIEN BAHUAUD »

This pretigious wine pays homage to the cart called "Chârte" in the regional dialect that Donatien Bahuaud used to deliver his wines. At once emotional and historic, this vehicule was built by one of his loved ones.

Careful maturing has enhanced this Touraine, which reveals a rich palate with nice aromas.

#### VINE-GROWING & WINEMAKING

#### Grape variety: Sauvignon

**Soils / Terroirs** : sandy and stony soil with plenty of flintstone

Vinification details : Our oenologists take great care when making this wine. After direct pressing, the fermentation is carried out at a low temperature in thermoregulated vats. Well mastered temperatures favor the development of the Sauvignon's delicate aromas. The presence of sulphites is reduced by the use of neutral gas which limits the risk of oxidation and conserves the harvest's freshness and fruity aromas.

Maturing period : 4 months

#### THE VINEYARD

Representing an average age of 25 years, the vines are planted in a sandy and stony soil with plenty of flintstone. The composition and the aerated structure of these soils provide top quality grapes that produce in turn refined and light wines. They also reflect sunlight on the bunches thereby favoring their development.

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# VOUVRAY L'Alcôve White – 2018 Complex and aromatic

#### «A TRIBUTE TO CAVE DWELLERS»

This prestigious wine evokes the interesting architecture that can be found in many troglodyte homes in Touraine: a dwelling carved out of a tuffeau stone wall. Careful maturing has enhanced this Vouvray which reveals good freshness and a long finish.

#### VINE-GROWING & WINEMAKING

Grape variety: Chenin Soils/Terroirs: chalk-clay and flintstone Vinification details : Our oenologists take great care when making this wine. A 3-hour skin maceration is carried out to fully extract the aromas. Fermentation at a high temperature (20-22°C) produces tropical fruit aromas. Maturing period : 5 months on lees

#### THE VINEYARD

Representing an average age of 40 years old, the vines are located in Vernou sur Brenne, Rochecorbon and Vouvray where they benefit from a chalk-clay and flintstone soil.

COLOR T Pale yellow with ivory tints.

AROMAS T Expressive with notes of tropical fruit (pineapple) and mineral aromas (flint-stone and pebbles).

**ON THE PALATE T** Fresh attack. Very full, with notes of

well ripened fruit and a long finish. Very nice balance on the palate.

Ideal with seafood, white meat with gravy, grilled fish or even goat's cheese.

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#### «A TRIBUTE TO THE TERROIR OF ANJOU»

This prestigious wine evokes the typical rock located in Anjou comprising pieces of shell called "faluns". Its terroir boasts countless fossiles that can be easily picked up from the ground. Careful maturing has enhanced this Rosé d'Anjou, which displays impressive balance and tasty aromas.

#### VINE-GROWING & WINEMAKING

**Grape variety**: Gamay, Grolleau, Pineau d'Aunis **Vinification details :** The grapes are pressed immediately after the harvest to conserve the fruit's crispness and aromas. The wine is protected from the effects of oxygen to conserve its qualities. **Maturing period**: 4 months

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# **COTEAUX DU LAYON** *Les Vallons With – 2018*

Balanced and Fruity

#### «A TRIBUTE TO THE LANDSCAPE OF LAYON »

This is a prestigious wine evoking the small valleys marking the appellation's landscapes. The area's schist and slate soils support and shape the vines, and boast a mosaic of changing colors depending upon the seasons. This Coteaux du Layon is magnified by careful ageing.

#### VINE-GROWING & WINEMAKING

#### Grape Variety: Chenin blanc

Winemaking details : The house's oenologists have taken great care in the elaboration of this product to provide you with a well-balanced and fruity Coteaux du Layon. The proximity of the Layon river and sunny autumn afternoons offer ideal conditions for the development of noble rot. The botrytis cinerea fungus that brings about this noble rot produces berries that are concentrated in sugar and aromas. Handpicking ensures that only the best grapes are used to make this wine. After direct pressing, fermentation is undertaken at a controlled temperature to promote the release of aromas and is stopped by the cold, thereby guaranteeing good balance between the sugar and the acidity. Maturing period : 4 months

#### «A TASTY AND ROUND CABERNET D'ANJOU»

As we are concerned about preserving the terroir and the local biodiversity, steps have been taken to convert the vineyard over to organic growing since 2016. As a result, the use of chemical treatments is excluded in view of respecting the soils and of favoring the expression of the qualities of our terroir and its grape varieties.

#### VINE-GROWING & WINEMAKING

Grape Variety: Cabernet Franc

Winemaking details : Cabernet Franc, the leading grape variety of the Loire Valley, benefits here from the full expertise of our oenologists and entirely expresses red berry aromas. After direct pressing, the fermentation is carried out at a controlled temperature between 16°and 20°C, thereby favoring the development of aromas and producing a crisp and fruity wine.

Maturing period : 4 months

#### VINEYARD

The vineyard is located on a schist terroir. It maintains warm temperatures, thereby allowing the fruit to perfectly mature. Moreover, our growers use one of the best rootstocks: Riparia Gloire from Montpellier. The vine develops a low yield, thereby allowing the grapes to reach peak ripeness.

The vineyard is currently in its third year of conversion over to organic winegrowing.

# SAINT NICOLAS DE BOURGUEIL Les Terroirs Bio Red – 2017

Full bodied

#### **« ORGANIC IN A SANDY TERROIR »**

We have carefully selected parcels situated in a sandy gravelly terroir, typical of the appellation. They have been grown according to organic farming techniques since the 2013 vintage, and produce an ample and strong Saint Nicolas de Bourgueil.

Precise, long and slow maturing highlight the full aromatic richness of this wine.

#### VINE-GROWING & WINEMAKING

Grape variety: Cabernet Franc Soils / Terroirs · Sandy gravel produci

**Soils / Terroirs** : Sandy gravel producing red berry aromas and nice suppleness.

Vinification details : The grapes are handpicked when fully ripened, thereby expressing straightforward fruitiness. The tuffeau stone cellar maintains constant temperatures all year round. As a result, it allows the wine to be made and aged in the best possible conditions.

Temps d'élevage : At least 6 months

#### THE VINEYARD

The parcels are located west of Touraine, close to the border of Anjou, on the right bank of the Loire. Grown according to environmental friendly practices since the 2000s, its conversion over to organic farming began in 2013.

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# **ANJOU BLANC** Les Terroirs White- 2017

Crisp and complex

#### **«SCHIST TERROIR »**

Situated in a schist terrroir, the vineyard fully benefits from the assets of the Layon Valley, most especially autumn-time mist that allows Chenin to achieve over-ripeness – a feature associated with great white wines. Keen on preserving the fine quality and true expression of this fabulous terroir, we are currently in the 3<sup>rd</sup> year of conversion over to organic growing and intervene as little as possible in the winemaking process.

#### VINE-GROWING & WINEMAKING

Grape Variety: Chenin Soils/Terroirs: Schist

Winemaking details: The grapes are hand picked and carefully sorted in the vineyard. After direct pressing, the winemaking and maturing is undertaken in a cool cellar in barrels used three times beforehand. During the maturing stage, weekly tastings determine the amount of stirring required to obtain the complexity of a perfect wine.

Maturing period: 12-month minimum with 6 months in barrels

#### THE VINEYARD

The vineyard is located in a schist terroir The schist-laden soil maintains warm temperatures, thereby allowing the Chenin of this wine to perfectly ripen. Soil tilling and grass growing help to supply a moderate amount of water - a key factor in the production of great wines for ageing.

The vineyard is currently in the  $3^{\rm rd}$  year of conversion over to organic growing.

AROMAS T Nice aromas of flint-stone with lemony flavors

**ON THE PALATE** Lively and fruity attack. Aromas of exotiq fruits and chocolate. Toasted notes. Mineral finish and good aromatic persistence.

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

We manage our vineyard without the use of chemical inputs and with the greatest respect for the soils, in view of favoring the expression of the terroir and the varieties' full potential.

#### VINE-GROWING & WINEMAKING

Grape Variety: : Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet franc Soils/Terroirs : Schistes

#### Winemaking details:

This wine allows Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon to achieve their full potential.

2017 was characterized by a hot summer that helped to produce well ripened grapes.

We take special care of the vineyard, by preferring to till the soils rather than using chemical treatments. During the fermentation phase, the marc is immersed to gently extract the harvest's juice and to preserve its fruity aromas. Ageing in barrels for Cabernet Sauvignon.

Maturing period : a 12-month

#### VINEYARD

The vineyard is located on a schist terroir offering good drainage and plenty of warmth, thereby allowing the grapes to perfectly ripen. Soil tilling and grass growing help to supply a moderate amount of water - a key factor in the production of great wines for ageing.

The vineyard is currently in the  $3^{\rm rd}$  year of conversion over to organic growing.

AROMAS T Pleasant black berry and black pepper notes come to the fore.

**ON THE PALATE** Impressive structure on the palate with round tannins.

#### VINE-GROWING & WINEMAKING
